THE CURRICULUM

- Students choose **6 SUBJECTS** – 3 subjects at the higher level and 3 subjects at the standard level or 4 at the higher level and 2 at the standard level
- Students choose one subject from each I, II, III, IV, V group (5 subjects)
- The sixth subject must be taken from groups II, III, IV (1 subject)

THE NUMBER OF HOURS

- At the advanced HL level – 240 hours. classes within 2 years (6 hours per week).
- At the basic SL level – 150 hours. classes within 2 years (4 hours per week).



THE CORE SUBJECTS



Theory of Knowledge

An interdisciplinary subject that develops the ability to think critically and perceive relationships between various fields of knowledge. The program is completed on the basis of the oral presentation and a written essay in English of 1,600 words on a selected topic.



Extended Essay

Each student writes a diploma thesis based on their own research and reflections. The work has a volume of approximately 4,000 words. It is the preparation for independent research work at higher education.



Creativity, Activity, Service

The aim of this program is to prepare students to function actively in the society. It is a program for the students' own development: artistic, physical and social.

MATURA EXAM



The student take the IB DP Matura exam in six subjects and can obtain a maximum of 42 points (1-7 points per subject).



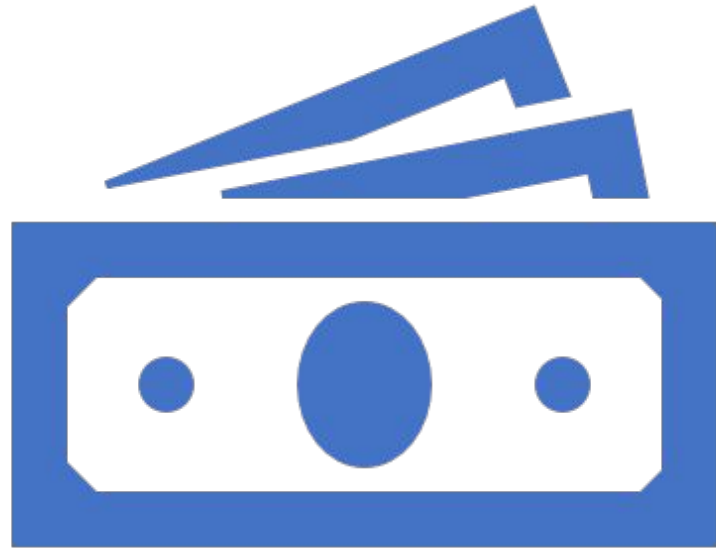
Additionally, the students receive a total of 3 points for an essay (TOK) and a research paper (EE).



The CAS course does not count to the overall score, but is compulsory.



The Matura exam is passed when a student who scores at least 24 out of 45 points and completes the three TOK, EE and CAS courses.



FEES

Each subject exam costs 85 euros.

*the fee for the May 2023 examination session was 510 EUR
